

<u>Peace River High School Parent Council Minutes October 13, 2020 at 7:00 pm</u>

3.0 Principal's Report

- Covid-19 preparation
 - o disassembled cafeteria furniture so can social distance
 - Purchased plastic tables for the gym to spread out for lunch
 - Any classes with tables have plexiglass dividers between student seats
 - Extra items and clutter in classes removed for more space
 - Custodian hours switched to school day so that all high touch areas can be cleaned 3-4 times per day
 - Staff sprays and cleans each desk and seat after each class before another student sits down
 - All students have their own tech device (Chromebook or laptop) for use during the school day
 - Seating plan recorded for each class to assist in contact tracing if needed
 - Hot lunch continues and is extremely popular
 - No cash accepted. Hot lunch cards and touch debit machine purchased
 - Plexiglass window on front so that only serving staff touches the food
 - Extremely proud of students in their compliance with mask wearing and sanitizing hands. Some reminders needed but generally student compliance is extremely positive.

Home learning

- Almost every class in the school has 1-8 students signing in through Google Meet and can work virtually with their classes
- Some students are just home for a number of days, others are at home for the semester.
- Transitions back and forth have been much easier having the students in their regular classes.
- Communication from parents and students have helped us to improve our technology and set ups in the classroom.
- o 20-30 students at a time working from home
- Students login, join in on regular class time, can ask questions and get the resources through Google Classroom

Staffing

- Mr. Ladd retired one semester early due to a family concern. Hired Bailey Campbell for his position this semester in Math 9, Sc 10, Bio 20 and Outdoor education.
- Mrs. McLeod on medical leave for an extended period of time. Started the year with Dave Cambridge and transitioned to Monica Greschner at the start of October.
- Mr. McIlroy joined our staff from Hines Creek and is teaching Math 9,
 Science 24, Grade 9 Options and Math 30-2 this semester.

• Grade 9 transitions

- More difficult without the visit to TA Norris, Open House and tour of Peace High
- o Many families came in the week before school to tour and meet us.
- o First day having 2 hours together in Health class helped a bit.
- Quiet and reserved for the first while as they get comfortable.
- Success blocks used to assist students with extra support in Math class.
 This was started after grade 9 collaborative response team meetings
- Grade 9 options with High School students has helped them get to know more students.
