-A restorative building is being build (big wood gazebo) is being built in the front of the school. Paid for by an Indigenous grant. Construction starts September 27

-Getting a revamp to the beach volleyball court. Came to fruition through lots of donations.

-PRHS is piloting a monitor that detects vaping, THC, screams for help, too many people, etc... they have been installed in the downstairs bathroom with a camera outside of the bathroom door.

-These monitors have greatly reduced the occurrence of vaping in the bathroom. More of those students have moved to the smoking hill.

-Wade would like to get two more for the upstairs bathrooms.
